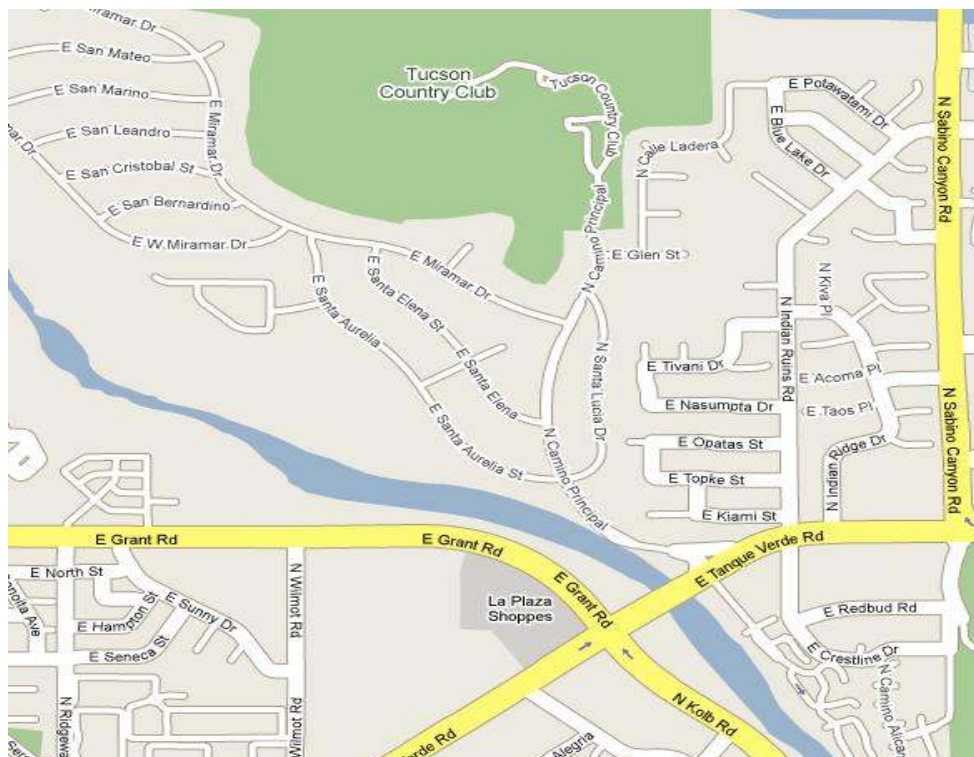
Pre-registration is a must. There will be some fun, low-keyed competition including, "**closest to the pin,**" "**longest drive,**" and "**longest putt.**"
